250	Clergy elected by authority outside of the local church
313	Constantine ends Christian persecution
327	State finances and controls the church
340	Church mixture: Greek & Oriental philosophies & ceremonies
341	Rome splits (east & west), now two empires
	Latin is the language of the Western Church
	Greek is the language of the Eastern Church
350	Christian temples & building projects
405	Latin Vulgate translated for the church
440	Celibacy becomes way of life for priests
500 — 1200	The Dark Ages

	Restoration of Word of God in common language (German)
	Invention of the printing press
1536	1st English version of the Bible (William Tyndale) — KJV translated in 1611
1630 — 1738	Restoration of Holiness (Zinsendorf, Wesley)
1700's	Restoration of the Evangelistic Message (Wesley, Whitefield)
1900's	Restoration of certain gifts of the Holy Spirit (tongues & healing)
	Azusa Street Revival in Los Angeles (Birth of Pentecostalism)
1960's	Charismatic Renewal
1980's — Present	Renewed emphasis on both the gifts and fruit of the Spirit
